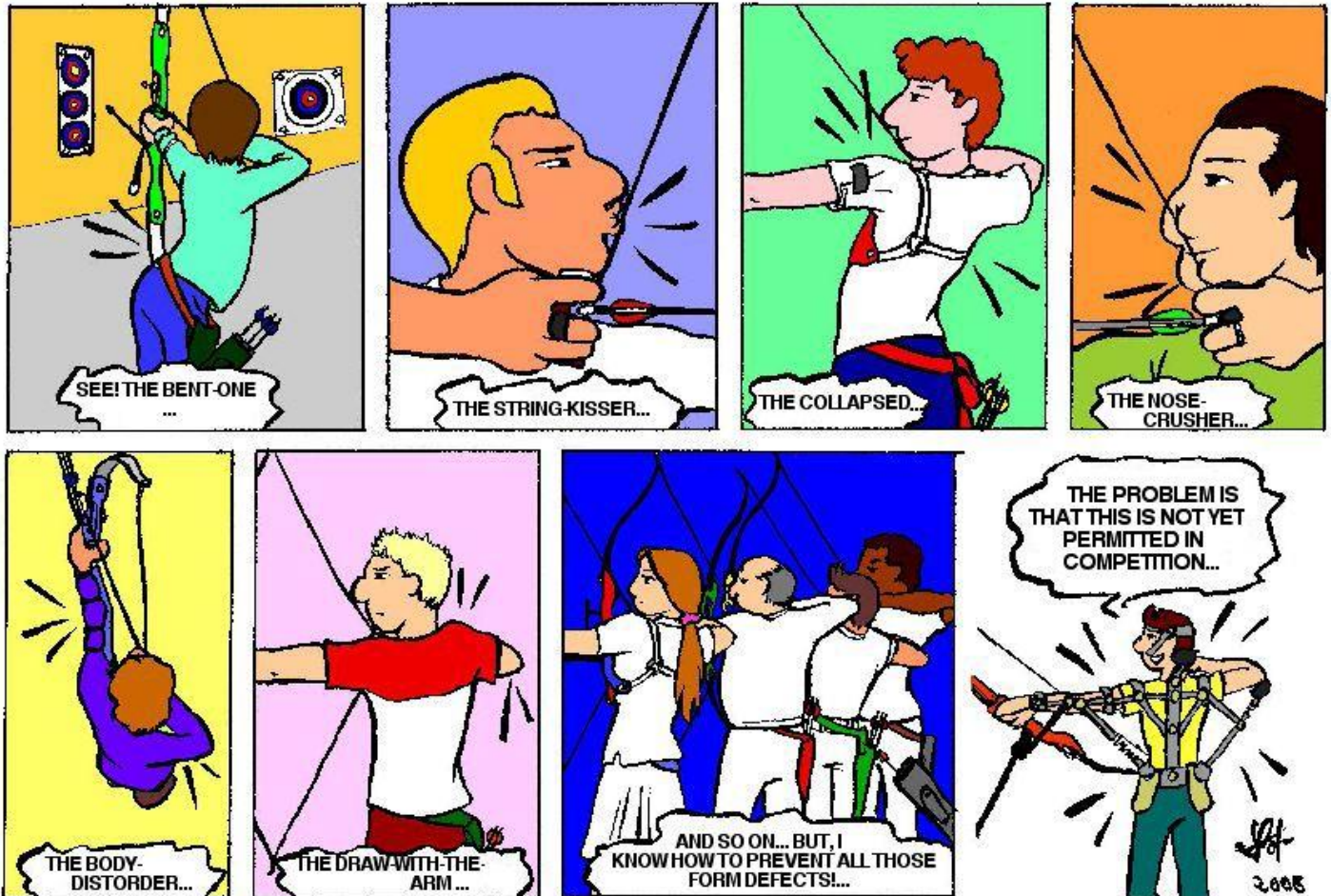

Famous Archers – Jack Churchill

Lieutenant-Colonel John Malcolm Thorpe Fleming Churchill, DSO & Bar, MC & Bar (16 September 1906 – 8 March 1996), was a British Army officer who fought throughout the Second World War armed with a longbow, bagpipes, and a basket-hilted Scottish broadsword.

Nicknamed "Fighting Jack Churchill" and "Mad Jack", he was known for the motto: "Any officer who goes into action without his sword is improperly dressed."

- There is an NFAA shoot on Saturday, August 11th. We still need kitchen help 12 to 3 pm. If available, please check with Tim.
- Spring clean-up was May 12th, 8 to 12. This was a mandatory work day for all working members. There was a lot of work accomplished, but still more that needs to be completed. Contact Tim Sheriff to schedule your make-up work if you were not able to attend.
 - Things left to be done.
 - 2 4x4s need to be placed in the parking lot island to hang the carved wooden course sign.
 - All bail houses on the field course need a coat of Thompson water seal.
 - There are 2 big cans of clear seal for this.
 - There is a little bit of dark seal saved for the new posts for the movement carved course map.
 - Both elevated shot platforms need sealed.
 - The chimney needs painted.
 - Indoor range floor needs pressure washed and prepped for paint.
 - Indoor range floor needs painted.
 - Kitchen walls need painted.
 - The downspouts still need snaked out. We need a snake with 100ft line.
 - There will be a second work day set to finish replacing the bad bails on the course.
- The outdoor league has started. It will be an alternating Field/Hunter round format. It will be 4 to 6 weeks, and there will be a second league starting in July.
- We are keeping a single volunteer sign-up list on our Facebook sit to eliminate duplications and lack of coverage. Please logon to volunteer. If you don't have ready access to a computer, please call Tim Sheriff, and he will put you on the list.

- The 3D season has started. Those of you with lane assignments please keep your lanes clear to shoot please. Please use the push mowers when possible, the John Deere should only be used for field and 3D setup, and the Cub Cadet is working, but please do not make adjustments.
 - The Father's Day 3D shoot had a great turnout, approximately 60 shooters.
- Please contact Tim Sheriff to make arrangements for a make-up if you need one. Working a tournament is a great way to make-up a work assignment! Besides, it's great fun and a great opportunity to connect with your fellow archers! The benches still need to be sealed.

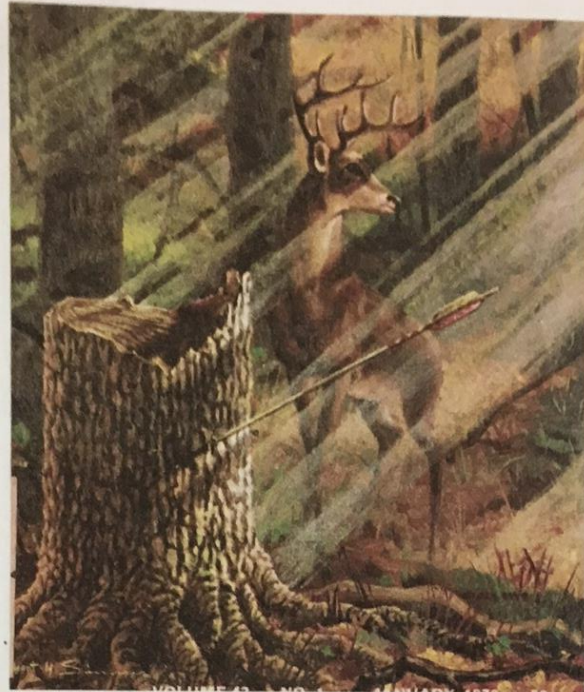
